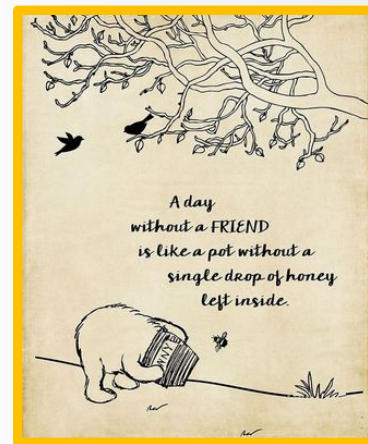
You could make friendship bingo game at home:
