## This Week's Prayer

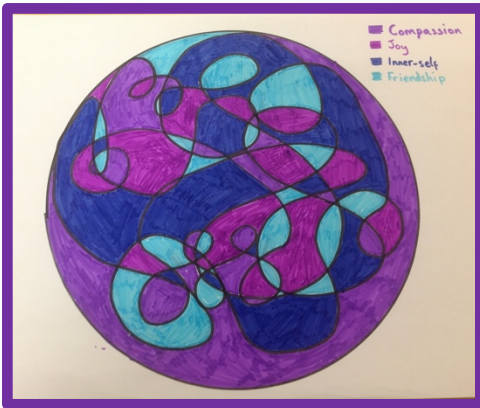
### A Prayer
