## Sharing

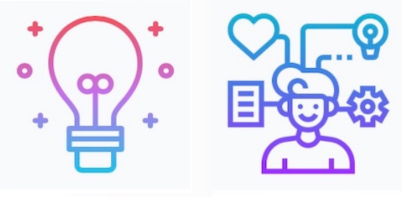

**Activity** – You can watch the video on our blog again to re-cap on the things the children say about sharing and the story of the Selfish Giant.

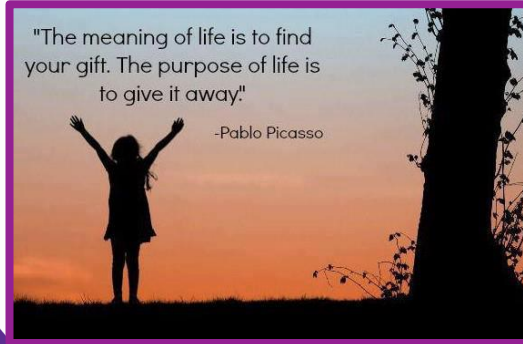
\* Carry out the sharing scavenger hunt. Write, draw or take pictures. If you would like to give them to Canon Pilling there may be a prize!!
