

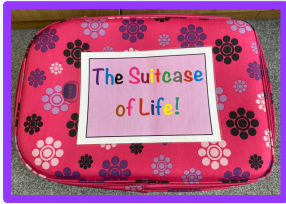

* How can you show these values and qualities to others?

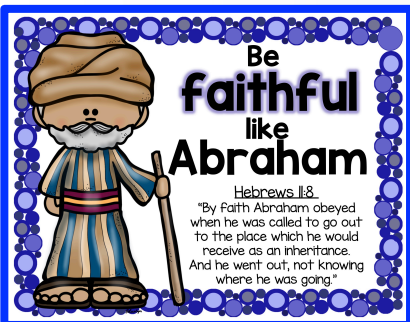


This Week's Prayer

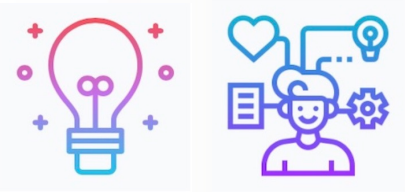

Ethos At Home

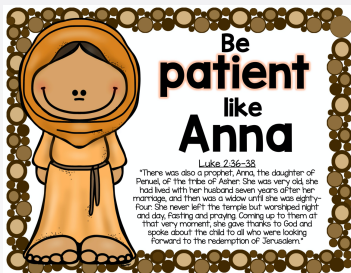


Activities you can do at home this week!
