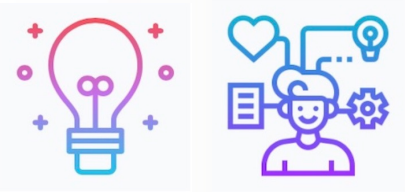

**You will need** – paper, pens, colouring pens, hand shapes and scissors.

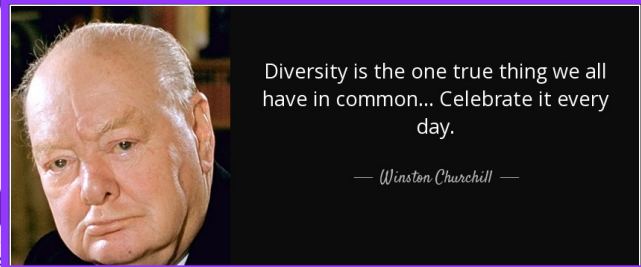
## Activity –
