Aim:

You will need – A selection of statements relating to honesty

Activity – Carry out honesty facts survey

First you need a selection of honesty facts and put them on display on a wall that is central in your school. We used the dining hall as children and adults pass every day. We left pens for people to add their thoughts and reflections. You could repeat this activity with any value of your choice. At the end of 2 weeks gather peoples responses, this may lead into a worship session or further activity.

Suggested honesty statements

- * Honesty is telling the truth
- * Honesty is straightforward conduct
- * Honesty is being sincere, truthful, trustworthy, honourable, fair, genuine and loyal with integrity
 - * Honesty is trusting people
 - * Tell the truth despite the consequences
- * Do you tell on someone if you know they are not telling the truth?
 - * Voice their opinion in a kind, thoughtful way.
- * If a cashier gives you more change than you should have, do you give them the change back?
 - * Admit that you have made a mistake.
 - * Would you copy someone's homework?
- * Tell the truth to others even if it upsets them?
- * When have you been honest with someone?
