## Let's Ponder!

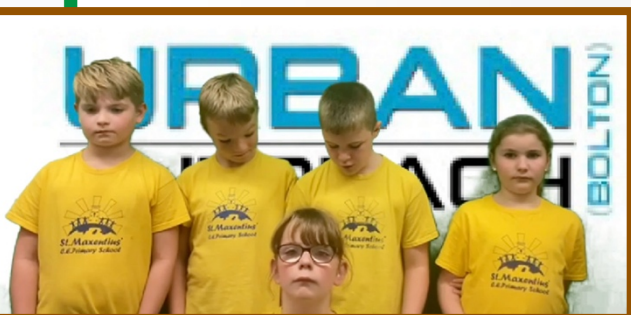


- \* This week we are looking at the importance harvest.

**You will need** - Harvest basket template from your teacher, pens, colouring pens and scissors.

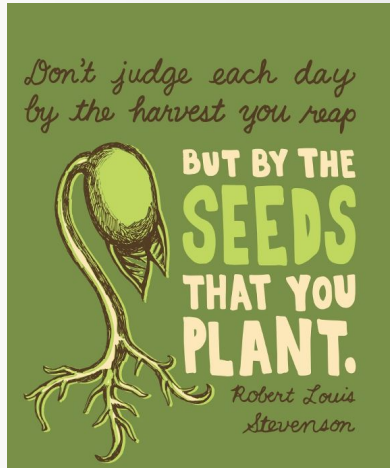
